Pecan Pie with a Twist

- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 2 tablespoons flour
- 1 1/2 cups light corn syrup
- 3 raw eggs, slightly beaten
- 1 1/2 cups pecan pieces
- 1/4 to 1/2 cup of Heath bits
- 2 tablespoons butter, melted

1 (9 inch) Pillsbury pie crust from the dairy case.

Mix sugar and flour together. Add syrup, butter, eggs, vanilla and salt.

Place pecan pieces and Heath bits in the pie shell before adding filling.

Pour filling over pecan pieces and Heath bits. Fill to within 1/4 inch of the rim of the pie shell.

It will swell as it bakes. Bake in a preheated 350 degree oven for 45 minutes.
